The children have been carefully chosen not just from the monastery school but also from the surrounding lake and mountain villages so that once they finish their training it is hoped that some of them will go back to their village and make a difference in the health of their community.

The course, which will run throughout 2017 will encompass training in community care, hygiene, nursing aid, pharmacy & traditional medicine.

The teaching will be conducted at the new training facility & the clinic at the monastery and also at the hospital in Taunggyi.
